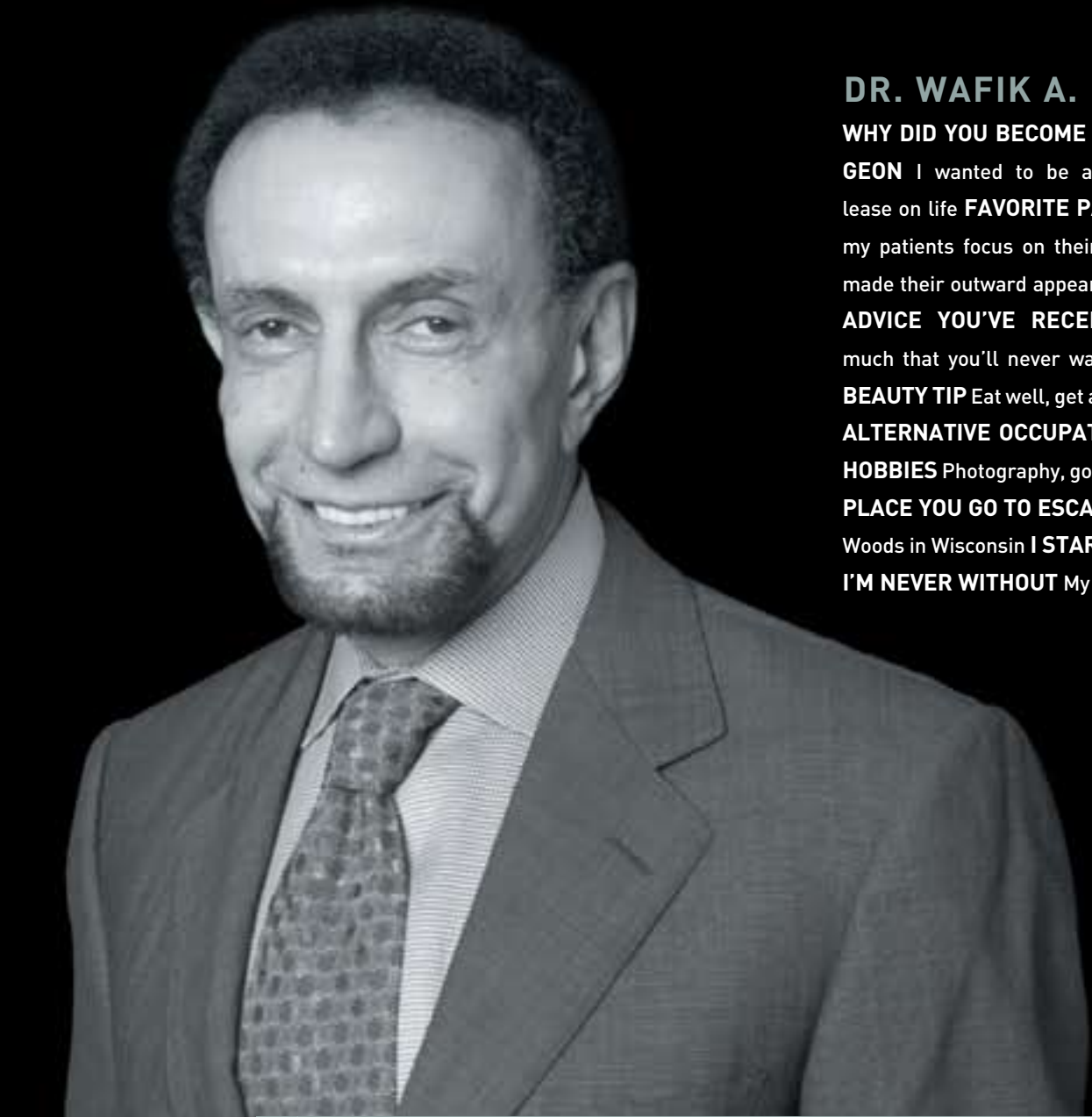

"A good candidate for liposculpturing is someone who has excessive fat in the cheeks, around the jawline and under the chin," says Dr. Hanna. ### RHINOPLASTY: THE FACE IN BALANCE

With a practice that focuses exclusively on the face, Dr. Hanna clearly has vast experience performing rhinoplasty. Over the years Dr. Hanna has reshaped thousands of noses. He is careful, however, to consider the whole face. For example, he says, rhinoplasty may not look its best if the patient also has a receding chin. "If needed, I will often do a **CHIN IMPLANT WITH THE RHINOPLASTY** in order to **BALANCE THE FACE**." Dr. Hanna follows a careful rule of proportion when it comes to analyzing the face. He says, "The sculpture of the nose has to be one-third of the face. The angle between the nose and the upper lip should be 100 to 110 degrees for a woman and 90 degrees for a man. The distance between the nostrils should be equal to the width of the eye. The tip has to be proportionate to the width of the cheeks. Studying all of these **PROPORTION RELATIONS** helps result in a natural look."
